The aim of the PMT Summer School in 2019 is to present theories, methods and techniques used in psychomotor therapy, expanding your understanding and knowledge related with 'The learning body' in order to improve your competences as a psychomotor therapist.

In our modern culture lifelong learning is a concept we have all adapted and for psychomotor therapists the body is the center of learning. From birth till the end of life everyone has to cope and evolve with the body in a world that changes really fast.

In this Summer School you will gain knowledge of the physical, emotional, cognitive and social aspects of the body in relation to health and healthcare.

You will learn how you can work with people using psychomotor intervention in order to become and stay healthy or to face with disabilities or other adversities that can affect them.

You will improve your ability to work with different target groups in educational, preventive and therapeutic settings, supporting individuals, groups and social systems (e.g. families, working teams).

Through working with the theme 'The learning body', you will be experiencing different ways to access thinking, feeling and acting allowing to improve your competences as a psychomotor professional.

Facts about the PMT- Summer School 2019:

The program will include the participation in open classes gathering students, teachers and professionals from the field of PMT. The classes in PMT Summer School 2019 include different areas of psychomotor therapy across the participating countries and universities.

- Up to 52 students, 6 teachers and PMT coordinators from 5 countries and 6 universities will be involved.
- Students will get 3 ETCS credit points.
- The students fee of 270 euros include:
 - bed and breakfast,
 - 4x dinner,
 - 5x lunch and coffee breaks,
 - social and cultural program.
